Cyfield event: The new era of Nicosia city centre



With the spotlight on the heart of Nicosia, a pioneering event – presentation by Cyfield took place on the evening of Thursday, September 19th, entitled "The new era of Nicosia city centre: The modern lifestyle and investment prospects".
